What's The Point?

Do I have to be a “writer?”

How do I submit an article?

You can submit an article by sending it via e-mail to: **thepoint@aasf.org**. You can send it in the body of your e-mail message or as a Word attachment.

Note, if your article is “time sensitive,” you must submit it not later than the 5th of the month prior to publication. That is, if you want something printed in the July issue, for example, it should be submitted by the 5th of June.
