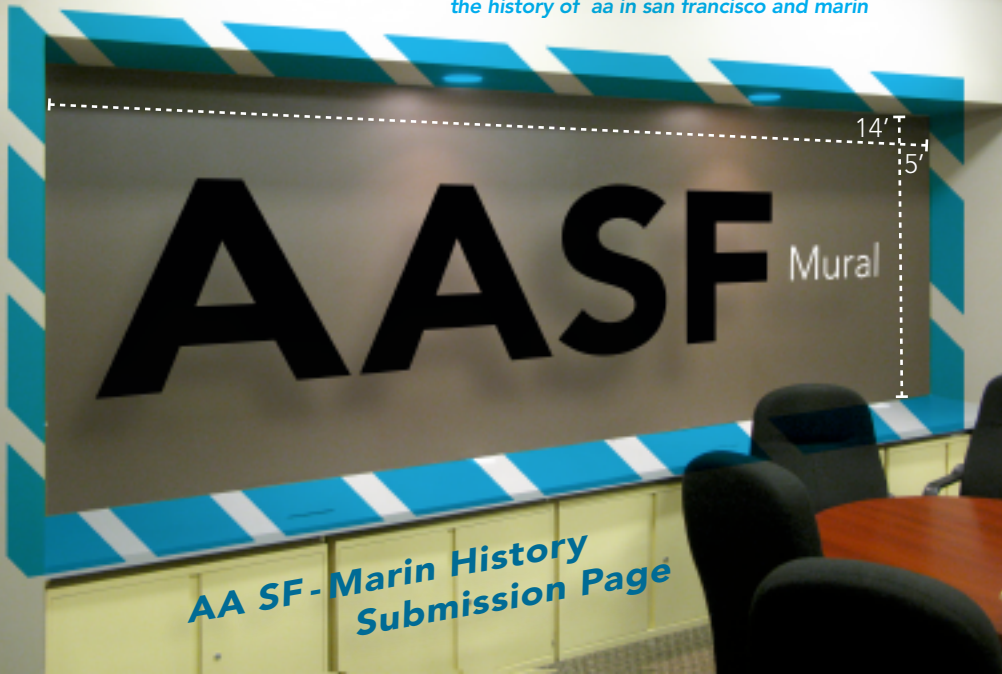


PROPOSAL >>

The hanging mural will be installed in a large, publicly visible space at the Intercounty Fellowship of Alcoholics Anonymous Central Office for San Francisco and Marin. The office is host to volunteer activities, Intercounty Fellowship Board committee meetings, social functions, and visible to patrons of the Intercounty Fellowship of AA bookstore within Central Office.

To enter a submission, artists are encouraged to draft a proposal, then fill in the form [AA SF - Marin History Mural Submission Page](#) for additional info. Instructions for submitting the proposal and additional supporting documents are to be emailed as attachments to the address provided. The proposal should include attached drawings or sketches of the proposed work, examples of previous work, and additional information to identify the submission.

Selection Process: All Artist Proposals will be reviewed by the AASF/ Marin History Mural Committee of Intercounty Fellowship Board of SF and Marin. The top three finalists will be presented to the IFB of SF and Marin for final approval.
